Behind the scenes there also many things that you may not see, such as insurance policies for all areas of our business, boat permissions, captain's licenses, Instructors licences etc.

Staff:

All Instructors at Greenwichdiving are at least Open Water Dive Instructors (PADI / SSI / FEDAS) and in some cases Master Instructors and many Instructors hold many Speciality Training qualifications.

All Instructors at Greenwichdiving hold the Spanish title of Technico Deportivo Nivel 1 / 2 and are registered as Instructors with both Valencian Community.

All staff at Greenwichdiving hold Legal Working Contracts with the corresponding Social Security and Insurance Requirements.

## **Insurances:**

Premises Insured with AXA Insurance, with Civil Responsibility Limits exceeding Spanish Regulations (RD 607 Art 8).

Boat Passenger Insurances with Metropolis Insurance, with Civil Responsibility Limits exceeding Spanish Regulations (RD 1575 / 1989).

Embarkation Insurances, with Lloyds of London with Civil Responsibility Limits exceeding Spanish Regulations (RD 607 / 1999).

Dive Centre Insurance with Lloyds of London with Civil Responsibility Limits exceeding Spanish Regulations (RD 10 / 2003) - 3.75 million Euros.

Diver Insurance with Lloyds of London, with Civil Responsibility Limits exceeding Spanish Regulations (For Discover Scuba, Scuba Diver and Open Water Diver Courses).

Instructor Insurance with Lloyds of London with Civil Responsibility Limits exceeding Spanish Regulations (RD 10 / 2003) - 3.75 million Euros.

Hyperbaric Chamber - A separate Insurance is also held for with Lloyds of London. Yearly Agreements signed the nearest Hyperbaric Chamber is situated in the Hospital Perpetuo Socorro within 1 hour of our centre. (RD 14/1997)

### **Compressor:**

Authorised Filling Station – Territorial Service Industry - Valencian Community Regulation (RD 560 / 2010).

Yearly maintenance Completed – Olaf Brandt (X 6655630 M) – Authorised Bauer Technician (RD 2060 / 2008) (latest Inspection Posted on Compressor).

Change of Filters – Bauer Filter Original 058826 - (Every 50 Hours) (Latest Change Posted on Compressor).

Insurance – A separate Insurance is also held for our Compressor with Lloyds of London.

### **Bottles & Regulator Control:**

Bottle - Hydrostatic Testing – Completed every 3 years, Registered in Annex 2 Control of Equipment and submitted to the Valencian Port Authorities. (Latest Changes Posted on beside Bottle Storage).

Bottle - Visual Inspection – Completed every year, Registered in Annex 2 Control of Equipment and submitted to the Valencian Port Authorities. (Latest Changes Posted beside Bottle Storage).

Regulator Control – Completed every year in accordance with Mares Technical Requirements Registered in Annex 2 Control of Equipment and submitted to the Valencian Port Authorities. (Latest Changes Posted beside Regulator Storage).

### **Emergency Plans:**

Updated every Month and Briefed to Greenwichdiving Team.

### **Boat General:**

Navigation Licence – Authorised Every Year by Port Authorities in accordance with Regulation (RD 285 / 1992).

Boat Residues – Checked every Year by Port Authorities in accordance with Regulation (RD 173 / 2009).

Captains Licences – Patron Portuario - Checked every Year by Port Authorities in accordance with Regulation (RD 238 / 2003).

Boat Navigation Certification - Checked every Year by Port Authorities in accordance with Regulation (RD 1434 / 1999).

Boat Communications Licences - Checked every Year by Port Authorities in accordance with Regulation (RD 1434 / 1999).

Oxygen, First Aid Equipment, Flares, Fire Extinguishers, Lifejackets, and Mobile Communications (all within tested dates) are available on all dives from our boat.

All dives are guided for FREE by qualified guides WITH A MINIMUM LEVEL OF DIVEMASTER.

Oxygen, First Aid Equipment, Mobile Communications (all within tested dates) are available on all our shore dives.

All Dives whether by Boat or Shore have a register of divers on all dives,

Our Dive Suits and Boots are Deep Cleaned (Bleached) every week and Antiseptically Cleaned every Day. (Latest Cleaning Register posted on Compressor).

After every dive, Regulator mouthpieces are antiseptically cleaned.

Greenwichdiving also complies with the Protection of Data Acts (RD 15/1999 & RD 34/2002) and The prevention of Occupational Hazards Acts (RD 31/95, RD 54/2003 & R.D. 39/97).
